No. 37-3/Legal/2004 dated 141% September 2006 and norms, standards, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time and based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee and EC Sub Committee, 1 am directed to convey the approval of the Council to Sree Gurudeva Charitable & Educational Trust Kattachira, Pallikkal P.O, Mavelikara Taluk Alappuzha dist, Kerala 690 503 for establishment of Sri Yellappally Natesan College of Engineering Kattachira, Pallikkal P.O. The approval is valid for two years from the date of issue of this letter for getting affiliation with respective university and fulfilling State Govt. requirements of admission.

The Society/Trust/Institution shell obtain necessary affiliation/ permission from the concerned affiliating University. as per the prescribed schedule of the University/ Admission Authority etc. The Applicant Society/Trust/Institution shall send information about commencement of the above courses to AECTE. Incase the Institution could not commence the above memboried courses for whatsoever reasons during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter, the approval becomes invalid and the applicant society/trust shall have to make fresh application to AICTE for grant of fresh approval.

The approval is further subject to fulfilment of following conditions.

That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and puilding and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per Council's norms and standards laid down, by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.

That the admissions shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are [a] provided as per norms and guidelines of the AJCTE.

- (b). That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
- That the admissions to the courses shall be made only after the affiliating University /University under whose (c) arroit the institution is functioning / State Bloard has given permission to start the course.
- That the Institution shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new (d): course (s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
- That no excess admissions shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any (e)

- (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than these approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE.
- (g) That the Institution shall not allow conduct of any unapproved course whether technical or non technical in the premises of AICTE approved institution/campus and /or in the name of the Institution without prior permission from AICTE.
- 3. That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.
- 4. That the button and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/guardians of students in any form.
- That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for impection by the Council or any body or person authorized by it.
- That the Director/Principal and the leaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are paid as per the norms prescribed by the Council for time to time.
- (8) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance if administrative and academic standards.
 - (b) That the tochnical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities initiating faculty etc. In the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be housed in the institution. Web-Ste. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
 - (c) That it shall be insindatory for the technical inalitation to meintain a web-site providing the prescribed information. The website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
 - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time.
 - (e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misropresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of AICTE approval.
- That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliating University / University under whose ambit the institution is functioning, and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
- That a computer center with adequate number of terminals. Printers, legal software etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.
- 11. That a Joint FDR is required to be created for an amount and period prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year any time for verifying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
- That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of misrepresentation, violation of norms and standards, mai-practices stc.
- That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-maid from the Central or State Government.

- The Institute shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. © 655/1998. Incase of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institutions, the Court of shall take appropriate action including withdrawal of approval.
- That the institution shall provide the following faolities for the physically challenged persons.
 - a. Class rooms, toilets and hostels to be made accessible to wheel chair users.
 - b. Resource room for visually impaired students.
 - c. Accessible Library
 - d. Counseling Centre for disabled students
 - e. Facility of Sign Language Interpreter
 - f. All students needing assistive devices to be provided such devices
- 17. That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time.
- 18. In the event of non-compliance by the Sree Gurudeva Charitable & Educational Trust Kattachira, Pallikkal P.O, Mavelikara Taluk Alappuzha dist, Kerala 690 503 with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions prescribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval or recognition, without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would solely be that of the Sri Vellappally Natesan College of Engineering Kattachira, Pallikkal P.O, Mavelikara Taluk Alappuzha dist, Kerala 690 503.
